

<u>Federica Agosta – Candidatura a Consigliere</u>

Federica Agosta was born in Milano on 01/04/1978, took her Graduation in Medicine in 2003, Post-Degree Graduation in Neurology in 2008, and PhD in Experimental Neurology in 2012.

She is an Associate Professor of Neurology at Vita-Salute San Raffaele University, Group Leader of the Neuroimaging of Neurodegenerative Diseases Unit at the Institute of Experimental Neurology, Division of Neuroscience, and member of the Center for Alzheimer's disease and related disorders (CARD), Ospedale San Raffaele, Milano, where she conducts clinical activity and research in patients with neurodegenerative conditions.

Prof. Agosta has a broad background in clinical neurology and neuroimaging, with specific training and expertise in MRI in neurodegenerative diseases including Alzheimer's disease, frontotemporal dementia, primary progressive aphasia and amyotrophic lateral sclerosis.

Prof. Agosta has been member of the Steering Committee of the Italian Society for the Study of Dementia (SINdem) from 2016 to 2018 and from 2022 to 2024. She also held the position of Secretary and Treasurer of the society from 2018 to 2020 and from 2020 to 2022, respectively. In SINdem, she is also the coordinator of the Neuroimaging Study Group.

Federica Agosta is also Chair of the Neuroimaging Society in ALS (NISALS) and of the Neuroimaging Study Group of the Italian Society of Neurology (SIN), and Co-Chair of the Management Group of the ALS-FTD Panel of the European Academy of Neurology.

Her research has led to the publication of over 340 Pubmed-referenced papers (H Index: 74, Scopus; 87, Google Scholar). In 2016, she has been awarded an ERC Starting Grant. Since 2016, Federica Agosta is Section Editor of the *NeuroImage: Clinical* journal and member of the Editorial Board of *Neurology* and *Journal of Neurology* journals.
